

Deadlines and Dates of Interest:

2009

April 30, 2009 – FY09 HSGP (Tentative): ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT - Cities and Counties must have a current emergency management plan that meets state emergency planning standards at the Intermediate level.

April 30, 2009 – FY09 HSGP (Tentative): ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT - Cities, Counties, and response organizations must be a registered user of the Texas Regional Resource Network (TRRN) and have entered mutual aid resource data into TRRN.

April 30, 2009 – FY09 HSGP (Tentative): ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT – Cities, counties, and emergency response organizations must meet the DHS 2008 NIMS compliance requirements for local governments to be eligible for homeland security grants. This is a DHS requirement that the State cannot waive or defer.

July 24, 2009 – FY09 HSGP (Tentative): Anticipated date of FY2009 grant award to the State.

August 3, 2009 – FY09 HSGP (Tentative): SAA makes grant allocations to regions.

October 5, 2009 – FY09 HSGP (Tentative): Regions allocate grant funds to previously approved local and regional projects and provide allocation data to the SAA.

November 16, 2009 – FY09 HSGP (Tentative): SAA sends out 2009 grant sub-recipient agreements to eligible city, county, and regional sub-grantees.

December 15, 2009 – Deadline to complete and submit COG Regional Interoperable Communications Plans (RICPs); COG/Regional Communication Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs); and CASM data Entry

December 30, 2009 – 2007 CCP, LETPP, SHSP, and UASI Deadline for sub-grantees to have all items using 2007 grant funds ordered.

2010

January 12, 2010 – FY09 HSGP (Tentative): Deadline for signed sub-recipient agreements to be returned to the SAA.

February 28, 2010 – 2007 CCP, LETPP, SHSP, and UASI End of sub-recipient performance period.

April 30, 2010 – 2007 PSIC Deadline for sub-recipients to have all items ordered.

April 30, 2010 – IECGP: Deadline for sub-recipients to submit reimbursement requests/invoices.

June 30, 2010 – 2007 PSIC End of sub-recipient performance period.

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
